Draw a picture, make a list, or stick in a photo of those that you have spotted.



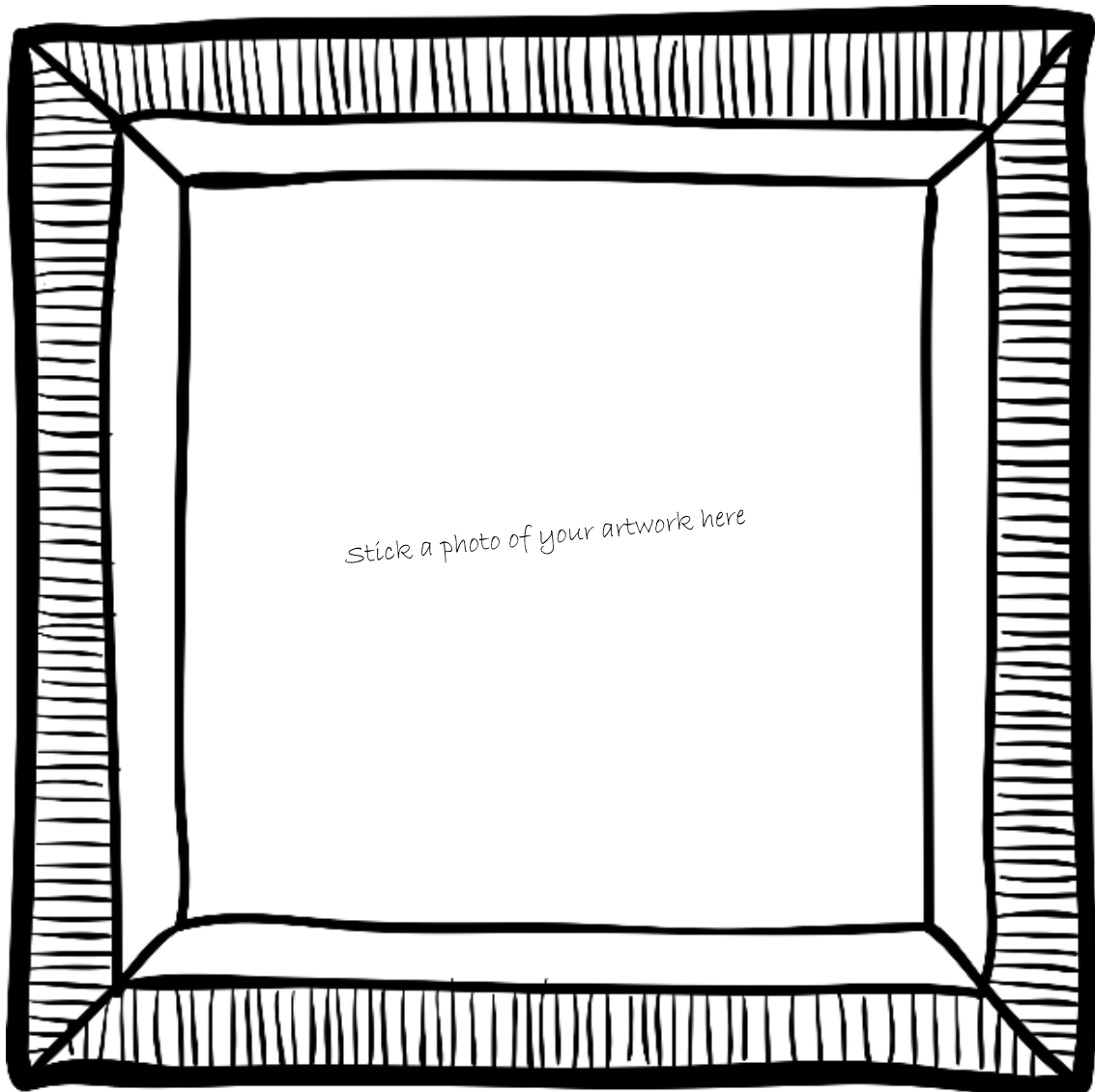
Part A: Take part in the Arts
