CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Open to all **aged 18 and under** living, working, or studying in the administrative districts of Fenland, South Holland, and West Norfolk.

Schools and groups may submit a maximum of **20 artworks** in any medium (excluding film or video). Physical prints of digital artworks are accepted. Works may have been created by more than one young person, for example, a collaborative entry.

Works should be **no larger than A2 size** (420 x 594mm); there is no minimum size.

Works can be submitted **unmounted, mounted, or framed**.

If framed, works must be ready to hang with mirror plates attached (see diagram); we can fit these for you for a small fee if required. Clip-frames are not permitted. Stretched canvas is fine unframed.

Please attach a label detailing your name, age, and the title of the artwork (if there is one) to your artwork. For two-dimensional work please attach a sticky label to the reverse. For three-dimensional work please use string to securely attach a name label. Labels are available from the Museum.

We cannot accept artwork that is not labelled.

All entries must be the Entrant's own original work.

The Museum can accept no liability for loss or damage to works submitted for exhibition.

We will do our best to display all entries in the exhibition, but if we do have too many, we will make a final selection. Our decision regarding acceptance and hanging is final.

Selected artwork will be displayed at Wisbech & Fenland Museum from **Saturday 28 March 2026 to Saturday 18 April 2026 during normal opening hours**. Entry to the exhibition will be free of charge to those showing a valid proof of entry postcard; you should be given one of these when you submit your artwork.

Appointed judges will select prize winners in the advertised categories. Their decision is final, and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

The following cash prizes will be awarded in each age category:

'Winner' £40 cash prize;

'Highly commended' £20 cash prize.

When the exhibition has ended, artwork will be **available for collection from Wednesday 22 April 2026** during normal opening hours and must be **collected no later than Saturday 9 May 2026**. The Museum reserves the right to dispose of uncollected artwork.
